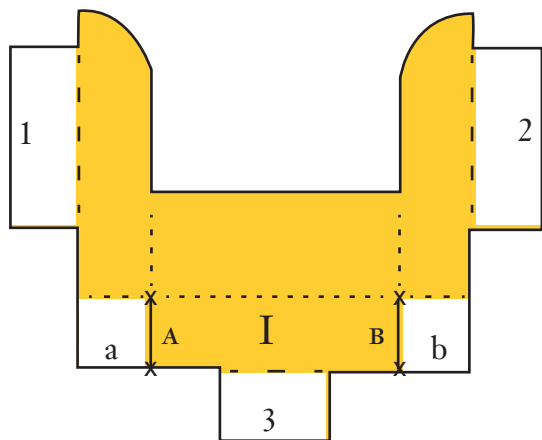
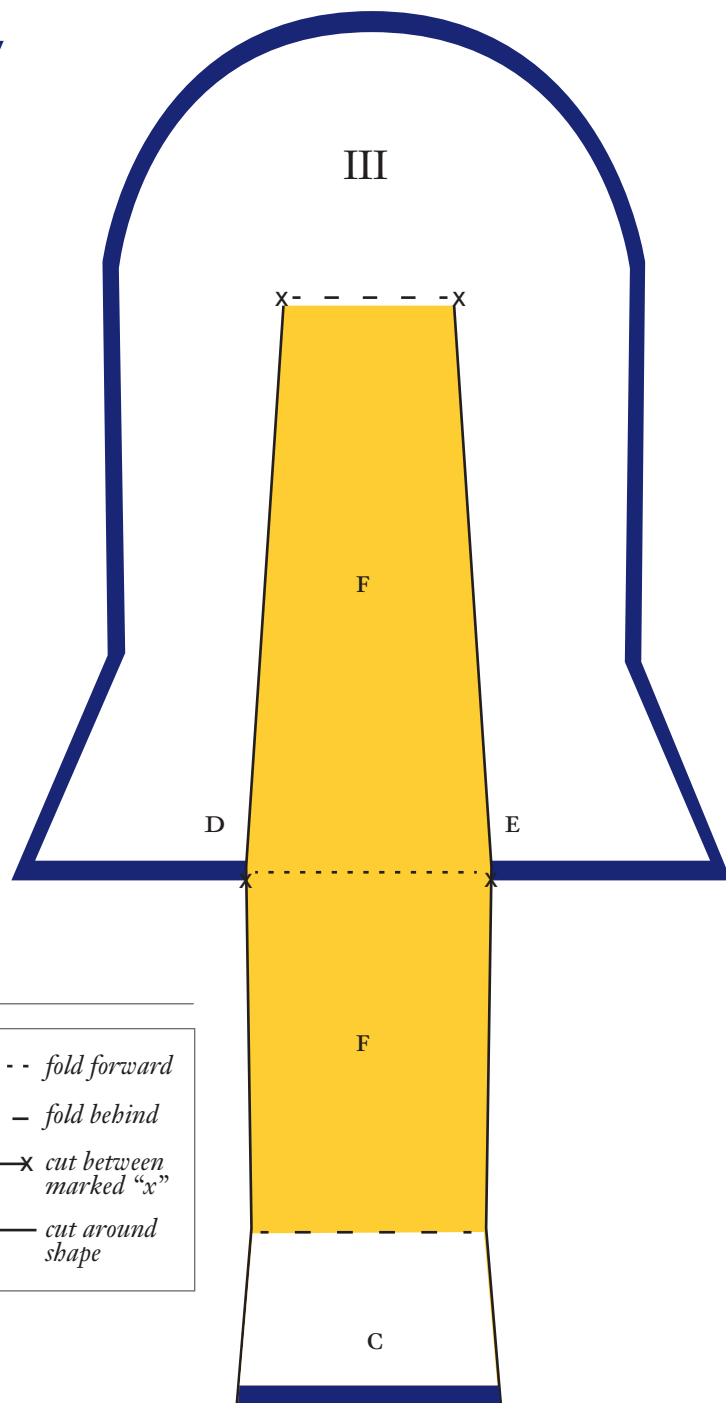
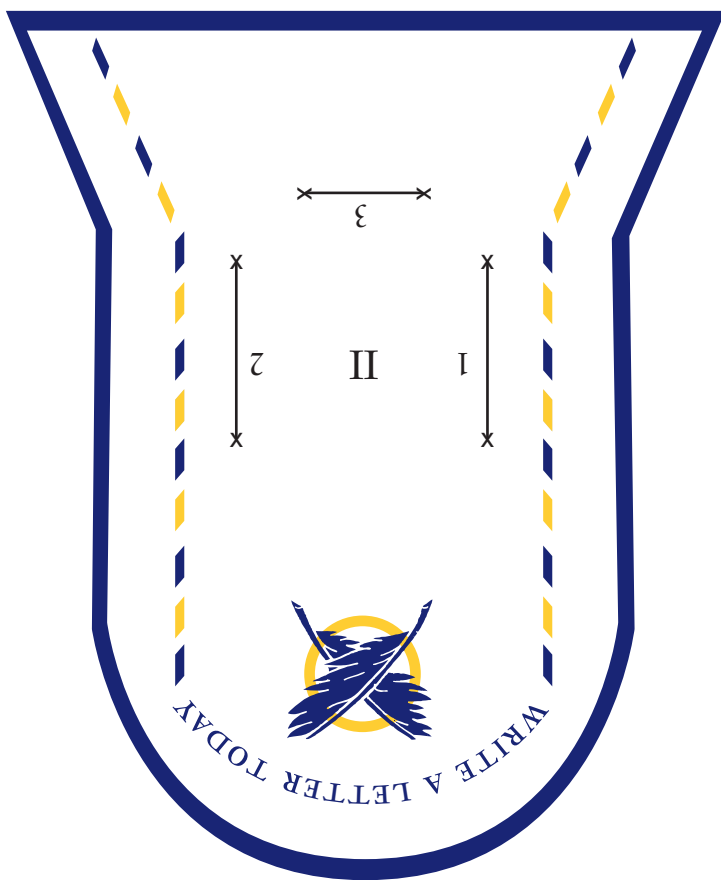


Remind yourself to write a letter everyday with this perpetual calendar!

Print this on card stock or glue individual papers to another paper to create a thick sheet. Cut out the three main pieces; use key to determine cut lines within individual pieces. Starting with piece I, score fold marks on yellow body, folding tabs “a” and “b” under “A” and “B,” and secure with glue or tape. Slip the tabs 1, 2, and 3 into the corresponding 1, 2, and 3 slits in piece II. Flatten tabs and secure to back of piece II. Glue the non-printed sides of pieces II and III together, making

sure NOT to glue the yellow strip of piece III during this process. Fold the yellow strip marked “F” on fold lines. Line-up tab “C” in between “D” and “E” so that the bottom blue line matches. This folding & gluing action leaves you with a stand. Now all you have to do is cut out the days, the dates, and months on page 2 of this download. Organize pieces and place them in the yellow pocket on the front of the stand. Now you have nice little perpetual calendar for your writing area.

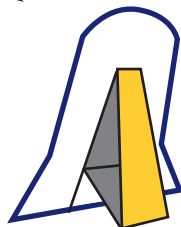
