

# PIGEON POST SCARF

For those of you who have been lucky enough to be sent a Pigeon Post and want to knit up a little scarf for their bird, here is a dapper pattern:

#### Materials

Rowan Wool Cotton in Navy (DK/8 ply) US 5 needle Tapestry needle Button

## Size

For LWA Messenger Pigeons Finished measurements: 9.5" by 1"

# Gauge

8 sts/9rows = 1" rib stitch

### Pattern

CO 8 sts and start 1x1 Rib as stated below

Row 1: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1

Row 2: repeat row 1

Repeat these two rows until piece measures 8", then make button hole.

## Make button hole

Row 1: K1, P1, K1, P1, YO twice, K1, P1, K1, P1

Row 2: K1, P1, K1, P1, P1 of the YOs and drop the other YO off the needle, K1, P1, K1, P1

Row 3: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1 through the button hole and let the old stitch drop off the needle, K1, P1, K1, P1

Row 4: K1, P1, K1, P1, K2tog, P1, K1, P1

Continue knitting in 1x1 rib for one more inch (or desired length) from button hole.

#### Finishing

Bind off making sure to knit the knits and purl the purls.

Weave in ends and sew button in desired location.

Button scarf onto your Pigeon for a dapper look and to assure he/she makes their deliveries toasty & warm!
